Eric is a founding member of Anthropological Theatricals in New York City and The Acme Corporation in Baltimore. He served as artistic director of 78th Street Theatre Lab from 1995 thru 2008. New York credits include work with Circle in the Square, 45 Bleecker, SoHo Rep, New Circle Theatre, Penguin Rep, The Brick, Dixon Place, Minetta Lane Theatre, LaMama, The Acting Company, Symphony Space, Cherry Lane Theatre, St Clements, Ensemble Studio Theatre, The Barrow Group, HERE, and Classic Stage Company. Chicago credits include work with Victory Gardens Theatre, Bailiwick Repertory Theatre, Steppenwolf, Chicago Dramatists Workshop, and Second City. Radio drama credits include work broadcast nationally over NPR affiliate stations, and in the UK over BBC channel 4. His work at the Edinburgh Festival Fringe has resulted in five Fringe First awards, four adaptations for BBC radio, two Best Ensemble awards, and a London transfer.
